

2023 Moretti 'Con Fusione', Larner Vyd

Tasting with Paul Lato earlier this year to craft our white blend, it became clear that a bountiful 2023 vintage provided loads of options for our white wine. Whether to lean towards steely crisp or lusciously rich was the initial quandary, but blend after blend captured both styles in one bottle. Hence, our newest creation: 'Con Fusione', a fusion of 90% Malvasia Bianca and 10% Sauvignon Blanc that couples lush orange blossom with a sharp, steely minerality.



2019 Thorne Pinot Noir, Rio Vista Vyd

The Thorne family own the well-known Rio Vista Vineyard, selling most of their grapes to other winemakers. They keep just 300 hundred cases worth of grapes for their own label, made by none other than Santa Barbara County legend Ken Brown. The 2019 vintage is full of juicy blueberry, blackberry and plum with hints of juniper and white pepper.

MAIL ROAD

2022 Mail Road Pinot Noir, Sta Rita Hills

Matt Dees of Hilt/Jonata fame takes advantage of Mt Carmel's soils (adjacent to Sea Smoke's Botella clay loam), to create wines marked by deep concentration, depth, textural complexity and bright acidity, and most notably, a purple-fruit and black tea note in their Pinot Noir unlike anywhere else in the AVA.



2019 Racines Chardonnay, Sta Rita Hills

When two of France's most storied producers unite to create world class wines that rival their homegrown bottlings, the wine world takes notice. Burgundy's Étienne de Montille and Rodolphe Péters of Champagne house, Pierre Peters, settled on the Santa Rita Hills due to its cool climate and highly varied soils. Great wines are grown, not made, so Ryan Hannaford was pried away from Oregon's Evening Land, Patricia Green and Double Zero vineyards to oversee the freshest takes on SRH Chardonnay in quite some time.



2016 Bonaccorsi Pinot Noir, Pence Vyd

For nearly 25 years, the Bonaccorsi Wine Company has been a beacon for fine Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and Syrah wine production. Boutique at its core, it has been helmed by three family members over that time: Michael at its inception, his wife Jenne Lee from 2004-2017, and currently, Rich and Joe Bonaccorsi (a family endeavor if there ever was one!). Their trademark earthy, sweet cherry has long been a standout in our room and clubs.



2022 OLG Pinot Noir, Our Lady of Guadalupe Vyd

Dave Phinney's first vineyard purchase in California is also extremely notable in our AVA, as it lays across 400 feet of diatomaceous earth, clay and limestone on the westernmost portion of the AVA. Overlooking Domaine de la Cote'e Bloom's Field vineyard and the outskirts of Lompoc, this will be one of the most talked about and sourced-from vineyards in the AVA for years to come.
