



Space Park Enology Club Tasting Notes

2017 Zotovich Vineyard Pinot Noir: Notes of candied cherry, pomegranate, hibiscus, and sage. Subtle tannins provide a long, soft finish from this sandy soiled vineyard.

2018 Bentrack Vineyard Pinot Noir: Aromas of anise, toasted fennel seeds, soy sauce, and cherries. Sticky tannins and balanced acidity pair nicely with notes of crushed flowers, plum, and dried persimmon on the palate.

2021 Radian Vineyard Pinot Noir: Medium bodied and mineral driven with vibrant acidity. Notes of bright raspberries, red cherries, clove, cedar, and star anise on the palate.

2016 SBC Syrah: This blend of Thompson and Watch Hill Vineyard Syrah in Alisos Canyon has notes of blackberry, roast beef, pepper, and violet with lingering acidity to help lift the finish.

2017 Watch Hill Vineyard EBA Syrah: Notes of charred meat, pepper corn, stewed berry, and yeast with a lively acidity that intertwines with the layered tannins

2016 Thompson Vineyard Syrah: Notes of tobacco, candied lilac, woody spices, blackberry liqueur, brandied dark cherry, cacao nibs, orange peel, and anise.

2019 El Rio (50/50 Tempranillo, Grenache blend): Notes of crème brûlée on the nose, as well as ripened blackberries and tart raspberries with a slight asphalt note. Elegant and bright, with vanilla and purple fruit gently dancing through the palate.

2019 Stolpman Vineyard Sangiovese: This youthful Sangiovese has bright notes of cranberry, green olives, cherry, raspberry, and black pepper. Bright acidity hits to provide a clean and concise palate with structured tannins.

2019 Estelle Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon: This medium bodied Cab has deep notes of plum, lilac, blackberry, tobacco, dark tea, clove, and black cherries. On the palate is tobacco and butterscotch.
