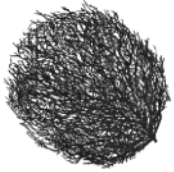

Space Park Enology Club presents Chateau Tumbleweed Winery

A virtual event with winemaker/co-owner **Joe Bechard**
Friday, January 19th at 7:30 pm, via Zoom



We are excited to step out of our California wine comfort zone and bring you an event that may surprise many of you. It turns out that Arizona is producing some great wines and Chateau Tumbleweed is one of its brightest stars.

Located in Clarkdale, Arizona, this fun and unconventional member of the Verde Valley Wine consortium has set out to break the mold and stamp out all of those stuffy winery stereotypes to boot. According to Kris Pothier, co-owner of Chateau Tumbleweed, *"We take our winemaking seriously, but we laugh at ourselves. We are building a business from a lot of love, and it attracts love to us."*

Kris and her then future husband, Joe Bechard, came from Oregon and started working at Page Springs Cellars (another member of the Verde Valley Wine Consortium) in 2008. That is where they met Kim Koistinen and Jeff Hendricks, their future business partners.



Realizing that the wine industry in Arizona was taking off, the four partners marshalled their complementary skills in vineyard management, winemaking, business management, and winery operations to create Chateau Tumbleweed. In 2011, the first vintage of Chateau Tumbleweed produced a mere 75 cases. The winery has grown markedly since then and now produces 5500 cases a year with grapes from the Wilcox and Verde Valley AVAs. Kris and Joe have never lost sight of the impetus behind it, nor their origin story.

At this point in the story, the obvious question is: *Where did the name Chateau Tumbleweed come from?*

True to form, the answer from Kris merits a chuckle: *"We blew in and got stuck in the fence of Arizona wine."*

Kris & Joe have given us several options for purchasing wine for our virtual tasting event:

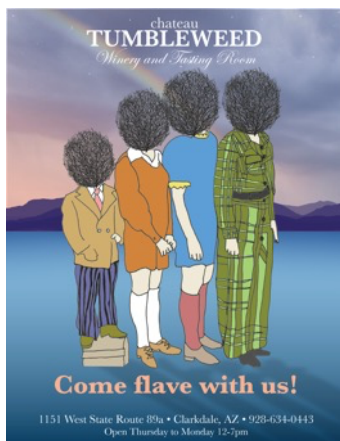
