The Space Park Enology Club is very pleased to visit with Aaron Walker, the longtime winemaker at the Pali Wine Company. What started as backyard dinners and a love of wine has grown into a family-run winery with roots across California's Central Coast.

Founded by Tim and Judy Perr in 2005, Pali Wine Co. blends tradition, curiosity, and community, growing from their early days in a Lompoc garage to their estate vineyard, natural wine project, and coastal tasting rooms. Pali is guided by two generations of the Perr family and their longtime winemaker, Aaron. They continue their commitment to wines that reflect people, place, and purpose.



The Pali website says: "It is impossible to imagine our favorite nights with friends and family, our most memorable meals, and our fondest memories without a glass of fine wine." This theme is embodied in two different labels: **Pali Wine Co.** and **Neighborhood Winery**.

Pali Wine Company crafts world class, critically acclaimed Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, sourced from vineyards in and around the Santa Rita Hills, where the transverse ranges, limestone rich soils, and cool ocean fog are ideal for growing Pali's grapes.

Neighborhood Winery was established to introduce creative, playful natural wines. It specializes in interesting, zippy, fun cuvées, both daring and traditional, that push the boundaries of conventional wine flavor profiles.
